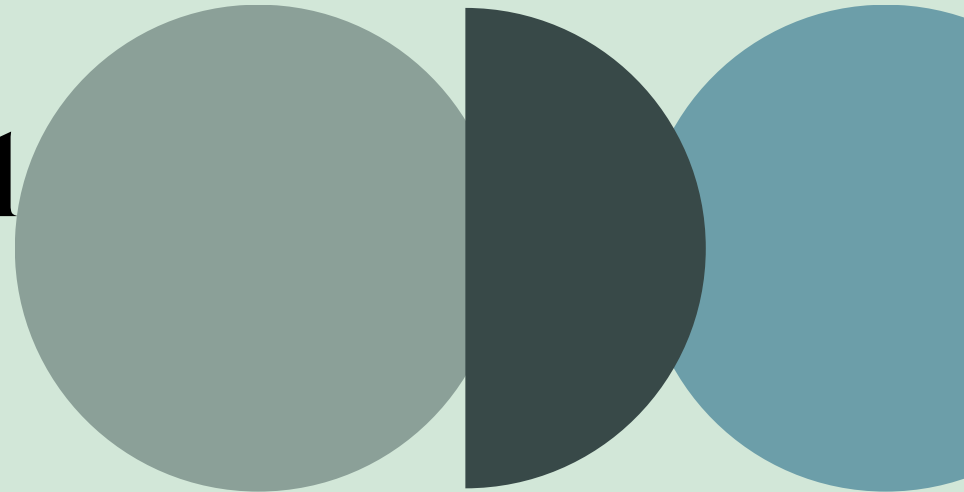

## Taxes + Fiscal Responsibility

A

### Red Light Cameras

On June 25th, the City Council considered a proposal to approve red light traffic cameras at two intersections within the City of Edmonds. Future 42 opposed this proposal as the intent appeared to focus on city revenue generation.

B

### Budget Adoption

On December 17th, the City Council considered a proposal to adopt the city's 2025-26 biennial budget. The proposal included \$18 million in new revenue under the assumption that voters will approve an RFA annexation as well as a levy lid lift property tax increase. Future 42 opposed this proposal as fiscally irresponsible.

C

### Regional Fire Authority (RFA)

#### Annexation Ballot Measure

On December 17th, the City Council considered a proposal to place a Regional Fire Authority (RFA) annexation measure on the April ballot. RFAs involve municipalities closing down their own fire departments and instead merging with larger regional departments. If approved, the City of Edmonds would be annexed into South County Fire for fire services. This annexation would create a new tax of up to \$1,000 per property tax bill. Future 42 opposed this proposal with concerns regarding the significant tax burden.

# Government Regulation



## Accessory Dwelling Unit Code Change

On June 11th, the City Council considered a code change to allow for greater flexibility in building accessory dwelling units (ADUs). This proposal brought the City into compliance with state law and allows for up to two ADUs per lot. Future 42 supported this proposal as it reduced regulatory barriers to building on private property.



## Flock Camera Contract

On October 1st, the City Council considered a proposal to place a 2-year contract with Flock Safety on a future consent agenda. This proposal would result in the establishment of a Flock camera program in Edmonds. Future 42 supported this proposal to improve public safety.
